## Fish Plantings

Last October we planted 250 Rainbow trout and 550 Walleyes. The trout were 13-15 inches in length and the Walleye were 6-9 inches. The planting's were done with private donations, SSLP Park contributions and monies from our Fish Fund.

We had the supplier tag 20 of the Rainbows and individuals who catch these will be given a hat or T-shirt. Several fishermen have report catching some of the trout and say they were a thrill to catch. Mike Holmes was one of the lucky anglers and was delighted with the taste.

Numerous fishermen have reported catching mature Walleye over the past year. These were from a planting several year's back. Jerry King and John Rowland reported seeing some big fish with headlights while ice fishing.
